### **#1 Christian Youth In Action**

***First, we want you to know about Christian Youth in Action®.*** It is an opportunity for teens (13-19) to be trained to present the Gospel of Jesus Christ to children ... and to serve God during the summer.

The teens lead an outreach called "5-Day Clubs" in child care centers, apt. complexes, Boys & Girls Clubs, in churches, or in neighborhoods.

Each club includes a Bible lesson, songs, games, missions, memory verses, and lots of fun with teens and our MIT students!

### **#2 Missionaries in Training**

In MIT training, 11 and 12-year-olds learn how to present the Gospel to children. They also learn to be helpers for the teen teachers. They help with:
